

COMPLEXITY OF THIS CASE:

- The sites of lesion in this patient are very rare-lytic lesions in the spine and involving the leptomeninges-1.0% [3,4, 8].
- In our case, both CD99 and FLI-1 were positive with negative IHC markers for other round cell tumors.
- The patient presented with paraplegia and urinary retention as primary complains.
- Acute onset of paraplegia is extremely rare manifestation of Ewing sarcoma [9].
- Early diagnosis and treatment in Ewing's sarcoma can result in favorable outcomes. The presence of benign musculoskeletal symptoms often leads to a delay in diagnosis with many patients being misdiagnosed and treated for disc disease [9,10].
